

Chorus Community Health Plans (CCHP) Member Newsletter 4th Quarter 2024

It's time to renew your coverage!

Open Enrollment begins on November 1, 2024 and runs until January 15, 2025. During this time you will have the opportunity to review your coverage options and choose a plan that fits your needs.

If you purchased your health plan through the Marketplace and are receiving a subsidy, it is a great time to update your healthcare.gov account to ensure the Marketplace has your most up to date income and household information. This will help to avoid any possible negative tax consequences when you file your 2024 taxes. There is no need for an update if there have been no changes. Be on the lookout for important documents regarding your Chorus Community Health Plans coverage. The renewal packet that you will received in the mail will include details on what is staying the same and what is changing for 2025.

Renewing your plan is simple

Once you have decided to renew your Chorus coverage, you have a few options:

- Want to accept the renewal plan? Simply do nothing and you will automatically renew into the plan described in your renewal packet.
- Need to make changes? Reach out to our team, your insurance broker, or the Marketplace (for those enrolled through the Exchange) to choose a plan fit for you.

If you are enrolled through the Exchange and receiving an Advanced Premium Tax Credit (subsidy) it is important to report any changes to your household income and information. We encourage members to do this as changes happen to avoid negative tax consequences.



Remember to effectuate your coverage!

Make a payment for your January coverage before January 1, 2025 to remain active! If you are currently set up on automatic payment deductions, these will continue at your renewal rate.

After you renew your plan

You will receive various documents to help get you started for the new year. Check your mail for the following things:

- Confirmation of enrollment letter
- 2025 ID cards
- January invoice
- Welcome packet

Wellness Incentives

Remember to schedule your annual preventive exam by the end of the year, if you have not already done so. A preventive exam can help you and your provider diagnose and begin treatment on conditions before they become worse. This exam is of no cost to you if it is completed by an in-network provider and billed as preventive. Please see our Preventive Guide for more information on recommended preventive services by age and gender. **CCHP offers a \$50 incentive to the primary insured and any covered spouse for completing their preventive exam yearly.**
